Conditions:

The age of Stud Beef Cattle will be the actual age up to and including 30th April 2010

Exhibitors to show Breed, Sex, Date of Birth and Class entered of exhibits on Entry form.

All animals must be registered or be eligible for registration with their respective Breed Societies, and in the case of Simmentals, Braford's, Murray Greys, Santa Gertrudis and Brahman must be classified A. or be eligible for classification.

All breeds to be ready for judging by 8.30am Saturday.

All exhibitors are expected to participate in the Grand Parade.

Animals must be led, bulls over 12 months by a nose ring. CLIPS NOT ACCEPTED. Bulls six months and under twelve months must be led with a nose clip. All bulls must be secured with a nose ring and halters.

All females over eight months must be led with a nose clip. Insurance will not cover liability unless properly secured. All bulls must be tied up with an effective halter and neck collar or rope whilst they are in the shed and not under the immediate control of an attendant.

Where possible, exhibitors are requested to have an appropriate sign, indicating name of stud etc., placed over the team in the cattle pavilion.

Where possible all grooms should wear dust coats when parading.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to arrange his own feed and feeders.

No bedding straw is allowed in the cattle pavilion. All cattle to be bedded on sawdust provided.

All Perpetual Trophies to remain at the Show Office after judging.

CLASSES FOR STUD CATTLE:

The following standard schedule is provided for each recognised Beef Breed. Exhibitors are requested to state Breed of Cattle on the Entry Form

1. Bull 8 months under 12 months
2. Bull 12 months and under 16 months
3. Bull 16 months and under 20 months. Class to be split if number of cattle warrant it. i.e. 16 - 18 months, 18-20 months.

Junior Champion & Reserve Champion Bull under 20 months

4. Bull, 20 months and under 24 months
5. Bull, 24 months and under 30 months
6. Bull, 30 months and over

Senior Champion & Senior Reserve Champion Bull Grand Champion Bull

7. Heifer, 8 months under 12 months
8. Heifer, 12 months and under 16 months.
9. Heifer, 16 months and under 20 months

Junior Champion Female & Reserve Champion Female under 20 months

10. Heifer, 20 months and under 24 months
11. Cow, 24 months and under 36 months
12. Cow, 36 months and over

Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Female Grand Champion Female.

POST ENTRIES:

13. Cow with calf at foot (calf under 10 month still being suckled).
Donaldson Trophy - Judged - 60 points for cow and 40 points for calf. Exhibit does not have to be bred by exhibitor
14. Registered Bull (any age) and 2 Heifers under 2 years. Exhibits to be bred by exhibitor. Any beef breed but of the same breed.
The Future Breeders Trophy and Prize donated by Davidson Cameron Pty Ltd.
15. Two Registered Bulls under 2 years. Any beef breed of the same breed and not necessarily a pair. Bulls to be judged on individual merit.
16. **The Oldfield Trophy** - Two Registered Heifers under 20 months. Bred by the exhibitor. Heifers to be judged on individual merit. Any beef breed but of the same breed.
17. **The Killarney Trophy** - Open Led Steer class (pure bred & cross bred) Milk - 2 teeth
Class 1 - Up to 400kg
Class 2 - 400kg & over
(classes may be amalgamated if numbers aren't sufficient)
