Conditions of Entry for Floral Art Section

1. Judging shall be under the standards of the Royal Horticultural Society, unless where otherwise stated.
2. The work in each exhibit must be done by the exhibitor but the blooms need not necessarily be grown by the exhibitor.
3. The Judges decision shall be final.
4. Any embellishments unless stated otherwise
5. Drapes permitted
6. All containers must be collected between 10am and 12 noon on Sunday and no responsibility can be accepted for their safety.
7. Limit size of arrangement to 24" wide.

To be judged under the Royal Horticultural Society Standards for Traditional Floral Art. Use of mutilated material in this section will not be accepted.
