

List of Banned Items – 2010

The Showmen's Guild of Australasia and the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW have agreed that the following lines be banned at Country Agricultural Shows as it is our view and aim to protect and attract families to the local Shows.

- Explicit and hardcore T-shirts
- Fake cigarettes
- Fuel type fire lighters (Zippo)
- Horns and trumpets
- Knives (including pen knives)
- Metal and wooden Martial Art Nunchakas
- Playing cards (nude or lurid)
- Pressure pack fart gas
- Drug related goods (including cocaine kits, bongos etc.)
- Pressure pack snow
- Stink bombs
- Water bombs
- Silly string
- Fireworks – crackers
- Laser pointers
- Bouncing Beans

Toy guns are acceptable, however the following are not:

- Pellet guns
- Ball bearing guns
- Replica guns (bullet type)
- Pop downs (throw downs)
- Potato Guns (Bullet Type)
- Eight shot caps
- Strip caps
- Roll caps
- Water Pistols over 150mm (6")
