Draw, paint or photograph a place or places in Gunnedah and surrounding district that you love or that holds a special meaning for you. All media are eligible including oil, pastels, crayon, pencil, acrylic, watercolour, digital images, photographs or any other 2D medium.

#### Entries in Section A must be:

- a maximum size of 100cm x 100cm
- framed (stretched canvas is acceptable)
- limited to six finalists per category per school
- submitted by **Friday 8 April 2011** to the Gunnedah Visitor Information Centre with completed entry form attached

Entrants should be aware that the work will be retained for this purpose. Entrants in the Open category are also invited to display their work at the opening of the Centre.
