They may be pressed if necessary and lightly starched.

In the case of a limited amount of entries a prize will be awarded only if the work warrants it.

NOTE: A fee of \$10 applies to all disputes. The fee will be kept by the Show Society Auxiliary whatever the verdict.

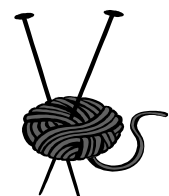
