Staging and Judging for Dahlias

Pompones, Charms, Nymphae, Miniature Cactus, Miniature Garden Cactus, Miniature Decorative Cactus. Staging unit is three blooms to a vase. Large decorative dahlias 190mm diameter and over. Medium decorative dahlias 152mm and under 190mm. Small decorative dahlias 70mm up to 150mm diameter. Large garden cactus dahlia 177mm and over diameter. Medium garden cactus dahlias 152mm and under 177mm diameter. Miniature garden cactus dahlias 114mm and under 152mm diameter. Exhibition cactus dahlias large at least 15mm diameter. Exhibition dahlias miniature 120mm and under 152mm. Charm dahlias must be over 76mm diameter and under 120mm. Pompones dahlias must be not less than 38mm diameter and should not exceed 42mm. Nymphae dahlias not less than 114 mm diameter and not more than 152mm diameter. Each dahlia to be named where possible. Judging shall be under the Standards of the Horticultural Council of NSW.
